Overview of your Berlin tour

Living here since I was a young student in the mid-eighties (with short breaks staying in Italy, Romania and USA) I love to share my personal memories with you and describe the special circumstances of staying in the divided city, the glorious moment of the fall of the Wall, and the not-too-easy transition to unification. Berlin is a unique place in Germany, and I really want you to get a feel for it.

The present is not understandable without the past. The worst part in German history is, of course, the National Socialist Dictatorship. We'll visit the most important areas connected to this time of persecution and murder.

As a German historian, I felt the need to concentrate my studies on this epoch. I won't overload you with numbers and dates. My goal is that you get an idea of what happened when and, most importantly, why. Complex structures and processes define the past as the present. Making it comprehensive without oversimplifying is my objective.
